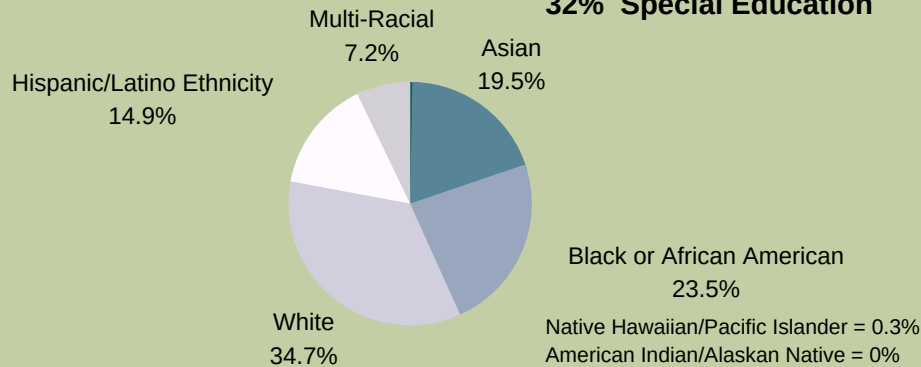


All preschool classrooms serve students from all four programs. Children learn through relationships, play and active exploration.

## EDWIN PRATT EARLY LEARNING CENTER

Named after Edwin Pratt, a local civil rights leader who was assassinated in front of his home in Shoreline on January 26, 1969, at the age of 38.



The Edwin Pratt Early Learning Center opened its doors to Shoreline Public Schools' youngest learners on Monday, January 7, 2019. In February 2017, over 73 percent of Shoreline School District voters approved a \$250 million bond to construct schools including the Early Learning Center. The 55,000 square foot facility at 1900 N 170th St. is home to all of the school district's preschool programs.
