

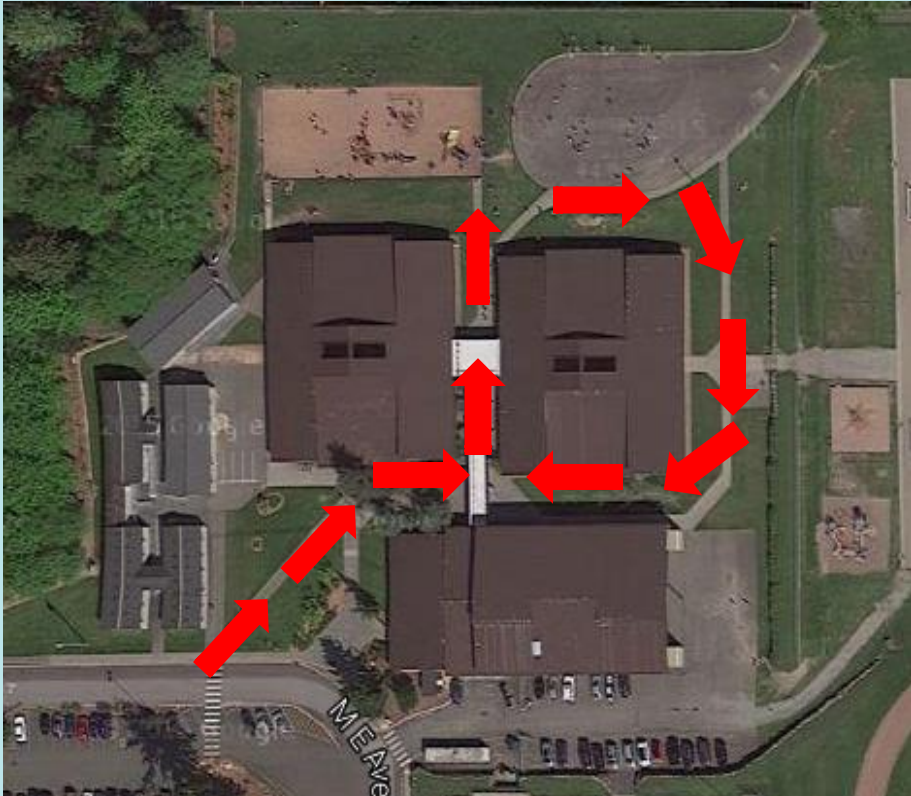

Common Playground Expectations

M.E. LEADERS ARE...

SAFE	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Listen carefully and follow directions of adults.• Use your words to solve a small recess problem.• Immediately tell a recess teacher about a big problem.• Give others personal space and keep hands, feet, body, and objects to yourself.
KIND	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Practice good sportsmanship.• Include others and use kind words.• Share equipment and take turns.
RESPONSIBLE	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Line up safely, quickly, and quietly as soon as the whistle blows.• Use the equipment correctly and put away when finished.• Play fairly by following the rules.

Slide	Stairs	Rock Wall	Bar Climber
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Slide feet first• Sit on pockets• Slide <u>down</u> only• Stay on the slide	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Use your feet• Climb up or down stairs	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Use feet and hands• Climb down when getting off	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Use hands and feet• Climb down when getting off

<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Use hands on bars• Keep one hand on bars at all times	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• One student on bars at a time• Use hands on bars	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Sitting and Hanging only

Primary Lower Playground

Blue Climber	Rope Net	Blue Saucers	Spinner
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Climb up only• One student at a time 	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Keep hands on the net• Keep feet on ropes at least 2 from the top• Stay on one side	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Sit or stand on the blue saucers 	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Keep both hands on the spinner• 7 spins for 7 habits• Stand clear• Wait in line for your turn• One person at a time

Primary Lower Playground

Spinning Monkey Bars	Climbing Wall	Balance Beam
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Keep two hands on at all times• Take turns• One student on at a time	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Use feet on the <u>sides</u> of the wall• Climb in the cut out circles	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Walk across• One student at a time• Start at climbing wall and walk toward houses

Intermediate Playground Boundaries

Play inside the red boundary lines away from classroom windows, fence lines, and rock walls.



Intermediate Upper Playground

Spider Web

- Keep hands on the web
- Climb on and off
- Climb or stand on the web
- Watch for others' hands while climbing
- 8 students at a time
- 3 students at top with a 1 minute time limit
- Jumping is not an option

Give others space.



Intermediate Upper Playground

Falcon Tower

- Slide down the slides
- Climb on and off the equipment
- Climb on the inside only
- Leave wood chips alone
- Stay off the railings

Soccer Fields

Soccer

- Stay an arm's length away from any other player
- Keep hands off the ball. Penalty for using hands is a free kick for the other team with all players standing 15 feet away
- Use proper throw in, corner kick, and goal kick for out-of-bounds
