

Buddy Rooms

Each classroom is paired up with another classroom as buddies (Tier 1). They will do activities together throughout the year. Buddy Room partners are used to support systems in the cafeteria, focused assemblies tied to Purposeful People, alternative workspace, and connection with multiple adults. This structure is used to build a sense of belonging and community. Buddy rooms can be used as a safe space when a student needs an alternative setting. This system can be used to add layers of support for students. Teachers can send students to each other's rooms for breaks or for specific plans (Tier 2 and Tier 3).
