WHAT HAPPENS WHEN A STUDENT IS STRUGGLING WITH EXPECTATIONS?

The teacher will:

- Follow classroom expectation plan which is sent home at Launch Conferences
- Confer with student to review and reteach expectations
- Communicate with family
- Refer to the office for additional help

The Administrator will:

- Communicate with teacher
- Determine consequence
- Problem Solve, restore, and repair affected relationships in partnership with families

HOW DO WE WORK WITH FAMILIES?

Whitman will:

- Communicate with the families if a meeting is needed to address concerns. This meeting will be initiated by either the classroom teacher or administrator to problem-solve the concern and create a plan of action to support the student
